Estimations of the activity:

1st type of activity:

- Replica during the seminar – 2-5 units
- Paper with PPP – 5-10
- Participation in the team in the business game – 5-10
- Essential participation in the dialog during contact hours – 2-5

Maximum – 45 units

2nd type of activity:

- Written paper (500-1000 words, 2-4 sources) – 2-7
- Written paper (1000-3000 words, 4-10 sources) – 5-15
- Translation of the texts (200 words – 1 unit)

Maximum 3 papers. First paper and second paper - till 02.06; third paper - till 03.06

Maximum – 45 units

Oral exam: 5-30 units.

Mark (can be changed according to the requirements of the administration):

NB!

- Maximum ball for the replica during the seminar can be received, if student gives well based (on data, sources) personal answer on the question of the professor and/or critique of His (Her) colleagues.
- Paper (oral) on the seminar must include plan, foundations (data, sources), conclusions on each chapter of the paper, PPP.
- Participation in the team in the business game means special preparation of the oral presentations and active participation in the work of the team.

- Essential participation in the dialog during contact hours means specialty prepared for the meeting questions on the essential questions, questions on the future work (oral, written papers, discussion about plan and sources of future papers and so on).
- Written paper must have comparative analysis of the sources and critique estimation of the position of their authors, foot-notes, bibliography. *The more modern essential sources of well-known authors student will qualitatively analyze, the higher will be final mark for the paper.*
- ***Students written papers can't include any text from Internet or other sources without foot-notes!***
